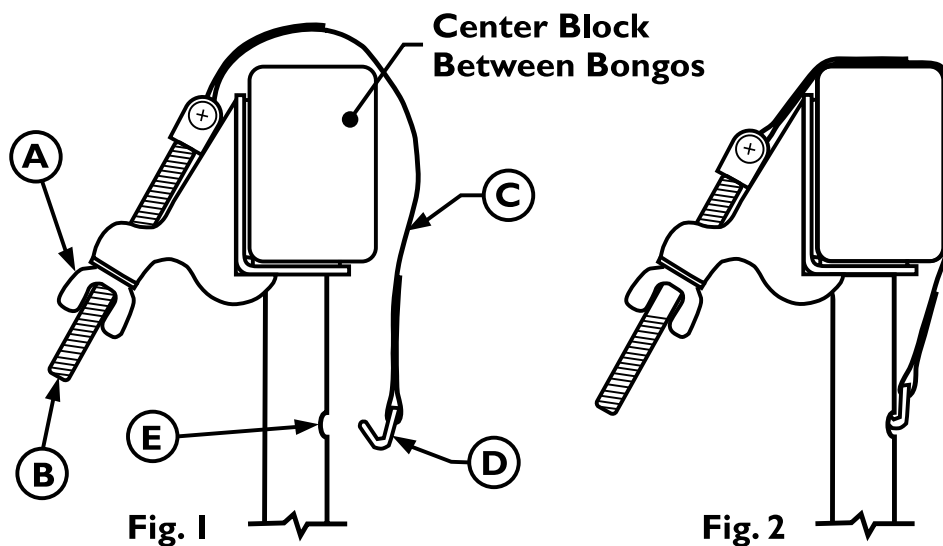
M245 Matador® Strap-Lock Bongo Stand

Congratulations on your purchase of the M245 Matador® Strap-Lock Bongo Stand. Products bearing the Matador name are designed to provide professional quality instruments and equipment at affordable prices. The Matador Strap-Lock Bongo Stand is another example of Matador's commitment to excellence and innovation.

To help you use this new stand more effectively, we have included this brief instruction sheet.

Important: Bongos do not need to be disassembled to attach stand.

- 1) Place bongos on stand. The center block must sit squarely against rubber pad. Be sure strap is out of the way.
- 2) Loosen tension bolt (B) by unscrewing the wingnut (A).
- 3) Feed the strap (C) & the hook (D) over the center block & between the drum shells. If the hook does not fit through, the hook & strap can be pulled over the drum heads & twisted vertically and then pulled through. The strap must wrap around the center block as shown in Fig. 2.
- 4) Insert the hook (D) into the hook slot (E). If the hook does not reach the slot loosen or tighten the wingnut (A) until the hook can be inserted.
- 5) Tighten the wingnut until the strap is tight and the bongos are secure.

NOTE: The strap must be tight so the bongos do not move while being played. For further assistance call LP's Customer Service 888-LPMUSIC.
